Comm Lead Program

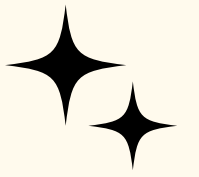
Maame is a big tech enthusiastic, she is interested in finch tech, and always knew the Comm Lead Program would be the best option to achieve her goals.
